NOTICE

As per the Kerala Prohibition of Ragging Act 1998, ragging in any form is prohibited in the college. It is a punishable offence according to the guidelines of the Honorable Supreme Court of India. As per the act and guidelines issued by UGC / AICTE based on Honorable Supreme Court of India's direction, ragging may comprise of but not be limited to the following activities.

- a) Any conduct by the students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
- b) Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.
- c) Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- d) Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person.
- e) Any act that affects the mental health and self- confidence of a fresher or any other student.
- f) Asking a student to do any act or perform something which such student will not, in the ordinary course willingly, do

Students are hereby informed that active or passive involvement in any such ragging activities inside or outside the campus may lead to suspension or dismissal from college and legal consequences leading to imprisonment upto 2 years. Anti-ragging squads will be keeping vigil for reporting any such activities. **Senior students are not allowed to enter first year classes.** They are also strongly advised to avoid unnecessarily wandering near the first year classes. Strong action will be taken against violators.
